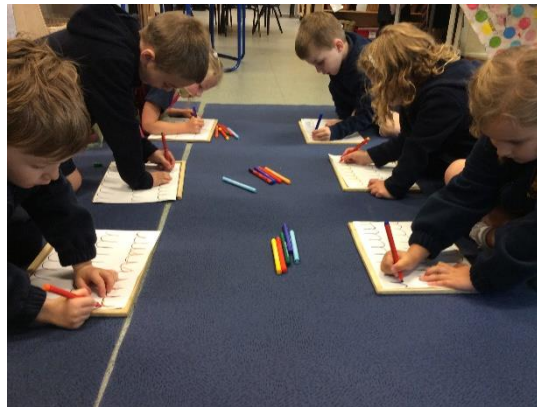




A day in Reception





You will be greeted at the gate by a familiar face.



We line up and then we go into our classroom.



We hang our coats on our pegs and put our book bags in our tray.
