name in this verse



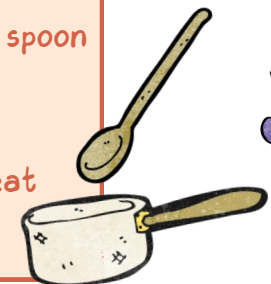
Becky on the bus
