Re: National Clean Air Day - temporary school road Closure Order

Thank you to those of you who have shared your views regarding the proposed School Street initiative affecting Vicarage Lane. Following on from my previous communication with you on 29th April, I am pleased to share that Amber Valley Borough Council has approved the temporary school road closure order.

The aim of the closure is to discourage parents and carers from driving along the road right up to the school gates. The proposed closure will take place on National Clean Air Day on Thursday 20th June during the following times


AM road closure time	PM road closure time
8.30am to 9.15am	3.00pm to 3.45pm

Residents will be allowed full access. We would be very grateful if you are accessing the road during these times could you please drive at walking speed when within the closure area. It is not necessary to move parked vehicles from the street. The closure will be under adult supervision and access will be maintained in all parts of the street for eligible vehicles which include:

- residents living on the road,
- visitors to residents' properties (including carers),
- disabled & Blue Badge holders
- Emergency Services,
- Taxis
- statutory public services such as gas/electricity companies,
- refuse collectors,
- postal service providers and deliveries, such as the Royal Mail and supermarkets
- breakdown and recovery vehicles, and
- any vehicle with special arrangements made by the School (i.e. school staff).
