**NO PE on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> October for Y4** - Y4 to come dressed in school uniform on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> October. The reason for this all children across DDAT are learning a song to be sung in unison. This will be filmed and compiled by a musical theatre company employed by DDAT – Kristian Thomas Company. The song is to celebrate 10 years of DDAT. Wednesday is the only day we can record the children singing and signing in the school hall. We therefore would like all children to be in school uniform for this event.
